Real Estate Title Insurance Company was established in Minneapolis, Minnesota

The company rebranded as Title Insurance Company of Minnesota, better known as Minnesota Title, with \$1 million in total assets

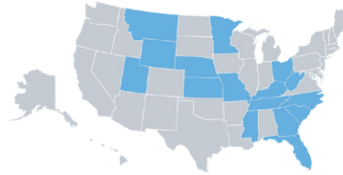
1938



Minnesota Title became one of the first title insurance companies to cross state lines, serving Minnesota, Florida, Georgia and Missouri

Minnesota Title acquired by Old Republic International Corporation

Mississippi Valley Title Insurance Company (MVTIC, formed in 1941) was acquired by Old Republic International Corporation. MVTIC became dormant as an underwriter in 2015 and Mississippi Valley Title Services Company was formed

Founders Title Company was acquired by Old Republic International Corporation, changing its name to Old Republic Title Company in 1995

Minnesota Title changed its name to Old Republic National Title Insurance Company, the flagship title insurance underwriter in the Old Republic Title Insurance Group (ORTIG)

Minnesota Title became authorized to insure in 49 states, Washington, D.C. and Puerto Rico

Old Republic International's common stock listed on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE:ORI)
